TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, J. H. Garraux County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statue laws of said State, against G. T. Ivester defaulting taxpayer of said County, strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said G. T. Ashmore, Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of One Hundred Thirty & 00/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantee R. D. Young have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee R. D. Young his heirs and assigns:

All those lots of land known as lots Nos. 10, 12 and 14 and 16 of Block C on the east side of Texas Avenue, as shown on plat of property of Julia D. Charles, recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County in Plat Book E, page 209, each of said lots having a frontage of 80 feet on the east side of Texas Avenue with a depth in parallel lines as shown on said plat.

Also those other two lots of land in the County and State aforesaid known as lots Nos. 9 and 11 of Block D, on plate of property of Julia D. Charles, recorded in office of R.M.C. for said County in Plat book E, page 209, each of said lots having a frontage of 80 feet on the west side of Texas Avenue with a depth in parallel lines of 200 feet.
