Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said Mary G. Bowen, her heirs and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
