## AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this the First day of April, 1942, by and between Piedmont Corporation, hereinafter referred to as Lessor and Oais Bar & Grill hereinafter referred to as Lessee:

## WITNESSETH

That the Lessor has leased and demised unto the Lessee that certain lot of land situated on the South side of West Washington Street measuring approximately 15 feet, more or less, on West Washington Street, said lease covering Ground floor only corner of West Washington & Laurence Streets for the term of five years beginning April 1, 1942 and ending March 31, 1947 at a rental of \$125 per month for a period of (18) months \$135 per month for a period of (6) months, \$150 per month for (36) months.

making a total of Eight Thousand Four Hundred & Sixty Dollars for the full term of this lease. The Lessee agrees to pay all rents on or before the First day of each and every month. Should any monthly installment of rent be past due and unpaid for more than ten days, the lessor may declare this lease terminated and enter in and take possession of the premises, but this shall in no way impair his remedy for past due rents.

The Lessee agrees to accept the building as is and any and all improvements are to be made by the Lessee. All improvements and alterations made in said premises during the term of this lease are to become the property of Lessor.

It is a condition of this lease that it shall not be assigned nor the premises sublet without the consent of the Lessor in writing.

The Lessee is to keep said premises, including all wiring and plumbing fixtures in repair at their own expense.

In case of total destruction of said building by fire or by any cause rendering it unfit for occupancy, either party or successors or assigns may terminate this lease and, or if Lessee becomes insolvent, goes into receivership or bankruptcy, Lessor or successors or assigns may terminate this lease.
