Jones, as Trustees of East Gantt School District (6-A) in the State and County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy-Five Dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the United States Of America in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents, does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said United States Of America, and its Assigns:

All that certain tract of land situate in Gantt Township, Greenville County, S.C., located along the center line of the railroad spur from Southern Railroad to Greenville Army Air Base, being 70 feet wide and 300 feet in length, containing 0.48 acres, more or less, and extending 35 feet on each side of the railroad track as now located, being shown on survey made by U. S. Engineers' Office, May 26, 1942, and being a part of the property conveyed to Trustees East Gantt School District (6-A) by P. Andrew Rogers, January 14, 1929, deed recorded in Deed Book 148, page 12, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S.C.
