All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about five miles from the City of Greenville, designated as a part of lot No. 3 of the W.-C.
Adams land fronting on road leading up east side of Paris Mountain, which road leads off the
Buckhorn road, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake in the center of road leading up east side of Paris Mountain
eight hundred feet from intersection of said road with Buckhorn Road, thence N. 54-50 W. 100
feet along the center of said road; thence S. 35-10 W. 655 feet to stake in line of W.-C.
Adams land; thence east with Adams' line approximately 117 feet to a stake; thence N. 35-10 E.
594 feet to the beginning corner.
