All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the south side of Cleveland Street, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 6 on plat of the property of Parrish, Gower and Martin, which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book G, page 197, and having according to recent survey thereof made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1935, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Cleveland Street, which iron pin is 175 feet west from the southwest corner of the intersection of Cleveland Street and McDaniel Avenue, and running thence S. 15-40 W. 97 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4-22 W. 86.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 69-26 W. 98.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20-34 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Cleveland Street; thence with the south side of said Street, S. 69-26 E. 66 feet to the beginning corner.
