All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, on the New Super National Highway No. 29 leading from Greenville to  
Taylors, approximately five miles from Greenville Courthouse, having the following metes and  
bounds, according to survey made by R. E. Dalton, C. E. September 15, 1938.

Beginning at an iron pin on the eastern side of Super National Highway No. 29, corner  
of property of Vance Edwards and opposite Highway Station No. 258-29-3, and running thence along  
line of property of Vance Edwards S. 47.0 E. 208.7 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with
