All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

and being a portion of Tract No. 1, of the Warren Rosamond property, having according to a plat made by C. H. Millard, Engineer, Nov. 1924, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin corner of Tract No. 1, and the tract devised to Warren Rosamond, Jr., N. 80-30 W. 1531 feet to an iron pin on Satter field line; thence S. 47-10 E. 1448.8 feet to an iron pin on road; thence along said road N. 34-30 E. 887.3 feet to the beginning corner, containing 14.50 acres, more or less, and being the remainder of the lands conveyed to Sonnie Mason by King David Rosamond by deed dated July 14, 1924; Sonnie Mason having conveyed 21.30 acres, more or less to J. A. Yancy.

Being the same property conveyed to Richard Davis by Sonnie Mason by deed dated December 18, 1924, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 105, page 181.

AND ALSO:

All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land situate lying and being in Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a part of the Warren Rosamond land and described more particularly by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the road leading to the White Horse Road at the corner of Tract No. 1, and running thence N. 81 W. 1581 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 24-50 E. 175 feet to stone on line of Tract No. 3; thence S. 80-30 E. 1602 feet to an iron pin in the road; thence with said road S. 34 W. 164 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same tract of land devised to Warren Rosamond, Jr., by his grandfather, Warren Rosamond by Item IV of his will; said will being duly recorded in the office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Will Book "O" at pages 142-146, containing five and eight-tenths (5.8) acres, more or less.

Being the same property conveyed to Richard Davis by Warren Rosamond, Jr., by deed dated April 22, 1925, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 105, page 329.

Richard Davis died intestate on the 22 day of July, 1929, being then a citizen and resident of Greenville County, South Carolina, leaving as his sole heirs at law and distributees the grantors and grantees herein; the said Tena Garrett Davis being the widow of said Richard Davis and the remaining grantees and grantors his sons and daughters.
