(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emma Lewis A. Higgins, Hattie Lewis, William Lewis, Louella Davis, Grace Lewis Miller and Elford Alfred Clarence Lewis, so as to vest a $\frac{7}{17}$ undivided interest in the tract to Emma A. Higgins, and so as to vest a $\frac{10}{17}$ undivided interest in the tract to Hattie Lewis, William Lewis, Louella Davis, Grace Lewis Miller, and Elford Alfred Clarence Lewis, all our right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning at a stone on east side of Rutherford Road and running thence N. 6 E. 8.28 chains to iron pin in Rutherford Road, thence N. $47\frac{1}{4}$ W. 13.35 chains to stone, thence N. $31\frac{1}{4}$ E. 3.70 to stone, thence S. $47\frac{1}{4}$ W. 6.36 chains to I. P., thence S. $45\frac{3}{4}$ W. 3.33 chains to iron pin, thence S. 34 W. 3.18 chains to iron pin, thence S. $31\frac{1}{4}$ E. 10.28 chains to a stone, thence S. $47\frac{1}{2}$ E. 31.40 to a stone (the beginning), and containing 17 acres, more or less, according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman, September, 1943.
