WHEREAS, Mary E. Jenkinson Griffin

on or about the 12th day of March in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-five exhibited her County
~~Crosby Jenkinson~~, for the County aforesaid, against Crosby Jenkinson and Morris M. Campell complaint in the Court of

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 12th
day of March, 1945, ~~19~~, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to Morris M. Campell

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-10169)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid
decree,
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Morris M. Campell.

All of the one-half undivided interest of Crosby Jenkinson in and to; All that piece,
parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on
the North side of Lanneau Drive, and being known and designated as Lot No. 29 on a plat of
property of John T. Jenkinson prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, July 1932, and recorded
in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, page 207, and being more
particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Lanneau
Drive, at corner of Lot No. 30, and running thence with the line of that Lot N. 21-44 E. 191.8
feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-09 E. 65.25 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 28; thence
with the line of that Lot S. 21-44 W. 197.3 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Lanneau
Drive; thence with said Drive N. 68-16 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner.

The above is one of the lots conveyed to Mary E. Jenkinson Griffin and her sister
Crosby Jenkinson by Charles M. Jenkinson, et al by deed dated November 17, 1932, recorded in
Deed Book 168, page 96, R. M. C. office for Greenville County. The foregoing conveyance is
made in consideration of the exchange of property as directed in the decree. A compliance of
said exchange was required by me before the delivery of this deed.
