No liquor shall be made or sold on said premises.
The Grantee shall make a sanitary disposal of sewerage refuse and shall not empty same
into streams or creeks.
No building shall be erected on said premises costing less than \$1500.00, except however
servants quarters and garages.
The within grantors, their heirs, or assigns shall not be liable to the within grantee,
his heirs or assigns for any claim of damages resulting from the operation or maintenence of any roadways, swimming pool, parks or play grounds or utilities within Wildwood Park area.
These restrictions are not intended as conditions subsequent but for the protection of
property owners of Wildwood Park, any of whom shall have the right for their protection to
institute necessary proceedings to enjoin and enforce compliance with same.
The grantors herein do hereby grant, and convey unto the grantee his heins, the night
and privilege of using the roadway now in existence from the property herein conveyed to the old
County Road Funning through Wildwood Park, for the purpose of ingress and egress.
In case the present building shall be destroyed by fire, the Grantee agrees to replace same with a building of equal value and appearance.
