

Maxwell, both of Greenville, S. C. did on the 31st day of August , 19 45, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth: FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given. SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is PIDEMONT BUILDERS SUPPLY, INC. THIRD: That the principal place of business is PIEDMONT, S. C. FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to operate a lumber yard and to deal in lumber, building supplies, coal, wood and kindred lines and materials, both wholesale and retail; and to do any and all things, incidental to the carrying on of said business and generally to transact all business as may be permitted under the existing laws or which may hereafter be conferred upon such corporations by law. FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) at the call of the Directors. SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Fifty (50) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the day of August 19 45, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: Jesse B.
