SEPARATION AGREEMENT.

This contract and agreement made and entered into this 5th day of March, 1946, by and between G. H. Southern, hereinafter referred to as Party of the First Part, and Martha E. Southern, hereinafter referred to as Party of the Second Part, both residents of the County and State aforesaid.

WITNESSETH:

That whereas, the parties hereto are husband and wife, having entered into a marital relationship on the 27th day of November, 1932, in the town of Williamston, State of South Carolina, and lived together thereafter as husband and wife up and until sometime ago when certain domestic differences arose between them and they separated and have since said time lived separate and apart; that two children, Thomas Southern, age 12 years, and Johnnie Southern, age five years, were born of this union.

And whereas, the parties hereto realizing it is to their best interest, happiness and welfare, and in consideration of the covenants herein contained, do enter into this Separation Agreement and bind themselves by the terms and conditions of same.

It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that they shall live separate and apart hereafter as though no marital relationship was ever entered into between them and agree and bind themselves not to molest or interfere with the social, business or financial affairs of the other in any way. It is further understood and made a part of this agreement that the Party of the First Part hereby releases the Party of the Second Part from any and all obligations and duties of a wife, and hereby releases any and all interest that he may have in and to any and all property now owned by Party of the Second Part, and in and to all property that she may hereafter acquire.

And Party of the Second Part does hereby release the Party of the First Part from any and all claims of support and from any and all duties and obligations that may have been created by reason of said marital relationship heretofore entered into between them, and Party of the Second Part releases and relinquishes any and all rights, including dower rights, that she has in and to all property now owned by the Party of the First Part and in and to any and all property that he may hereafter acquire.

It is hereby contracted and agreed between the parties hereto that the custody and support of the above mentioned children shall be and are hereby given to Party of the Second Part; provided that Party of the First Part shall not be obligated to contribute to the support of said children.

It is further understood and agreed that, by the terms and conditions of this Separation Agreement, the parties hereto, in so far as they are concerned and in so far as it may be possible, are restored to their status prior to the date of the marital relationship entered into by the parties to this agreement.
