This cause coming on to be heard, and being heard before his Honor, J. Will Pless, Jr., judge presiding, and a jury, at the April 1944 Term of the Superior Court of Rutherford County; and it appearing to the court that the defendant has been properly served with process by publication; and the following issues having been submitted to and answered by the Jury:

- 1 Where the plaintiff and defendant lawfully married as alleged in the Complaint?
 - Answer: Yes.
- 2.- Has the plaintiff been a boni fide resident of the State of North Carolina for more than six months preceding the bringing of this action?

Answer: Yes.

3.- Did the defendant commit acts of adultery as alleged by the Complaint?

Answer: Yes.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of J. S. Dockery, Attorney for plaintiff, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the plaintiff, William Owen Price, be and he is hereby granted an absolute divorce from the defendant Sula Mae Prise, and that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the plaintiff and the defendant be and they are hereby dissolved.

And it further appearing to the court, and the court finding as a fact that there are two minor children of said marriage, to-wit: Melvin Leroy Price, now about six years of age, and Patricia Sue Price, now about three years of age, who have been living with their father, the plaintiff, since the separation of their parents; and it further appearing to the Court and the Court finding as a fact that the plaintiff is a fit and suitable person to have the custody and control: of said minor children, and that the best interest of said children will be preserved by being in the custody of their said father:

It is, therefore, ORDERED that the plaintiff be and he is hereby granted full and complete custody and control of said minor children until the further order of this court

And it is further ORDERED that the plaintiff pay the costs of this action, to be taxed by the Clerk.
