Upon the full performance of the conditions and obligations of said note and mortgage hereinabove mentioned, this assignment shall be void and of no effect, and there upon, in that event the said Liberty Life Insurance Company will reassign to Paul J. Oeland its right, title and interest in and to the said lease so acquired under and by virtue of this assignment.
