

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of East Earle Street, which is 125 feet in an Easterly direction from the Southeast intersection of East Earle Street and Elizabeth Street, and running thence with the South side of East Earle Street, S. 71-20 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-30 W. 206 feet 6 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 71-20 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18-30 E. 206 feet 6 inches to the beginning.
