in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Carl Benjamin Garrison, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the eastern side of Mary Street, and designated as

Lot No. 123 of Map 2 of Camilla Park, property of John B. Marshall Estate, a plat of which is recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in plat book M at page 85, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Mary Street, which pin is 230 feet south of the southeastern intersection of Frances Avenue and Mary Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 123 and 124, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 85-11 E., 224.5 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence S. 11-02 E., 80.5 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots 122 and 123; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 85-11 W., 233.1 feet to an iron pin in the line of Mary Street; thence along the eastern side of Mary Street, N. 4-39 W., 80 feet to the point of beginning.

Subject to the restrictions as set out in the deed conveying the above lot to me.
