of Greenville by the Landlord for the purpose of widening Brown Street, and such reservation shall not be effective, and any deed shall so provide, until Brown Street has been widened and said 10 feet integrated into the street, so that at all times the property leased to the Tenant shall have a frontage on and accessibility to Brown Street.

All of the above is shown on a map thereof made by J. C. Hill, dated July 6, 1947--revised July 28, 1947, which was attached to the original of said Lease of August 11, 1947, subject to the revisions set out above.

Together with all easements for light and air thereunto belonging and attaching, but this shall not preclude the Landlord from increasing the height of his adjoining buildings; also all improvements now upon said property.

All of the above property being the property referred to in said Lease as the demised premises, etc.
