BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Highway No. 29 at the edge of a 10-foot drive leading into the property of W. E. Grover; thence along said Highway right-of-way in the direction of Piedmont, S. C., 165 feet to an iron pin; thence along the property now or formerly owned by J. E. Murphree in a Westerly direction, 223 feet to an iron pin, edge of property of W. E. Grover; thence along W. E. Grover's line toward the P. & N. Tracks, 149 feet to an iron pin at edge of said 10-foot drive; thence along the South side of said drive, 116 feet to the beginning point.
