CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT

This contract and agreement made by and between Jimmie Aaron Quinn, hereinafter referred to as the husband, and Ruby Kathleen Quinn, hereinafter referred to as wife, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, Jimmie Aaron Quinn and Ruby Kathleen Quinn were duly married and have lived together as husband and wife, and

WHEREAS, the said parties have a son, Thomas Edward Quinn, who is now three years of age, and said parties have been unable to amicably live together, having had divers disagreements, and difficulties, and are disirous of separating, now,

IT IS SPECIFICALLY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED by the parties hereto that they are to live forever separate and apart and all marital obligations and duties growing out of or arising from said marriage contract are hereby cancelled, revoked and declared null and void, and each releases the other from any and all of such duties, liabilities and responsibilities arising from the same, inasfar as is permitted by the laws of the State of South Carolina.

It is further specifically understood and agreed that the said wife does hereby release and discharge the said husband from and all duties, responsibilities or liabilities for her support and maintenance and from any claim in or against any property, real or personal, which the said husband now has or may hereinafter acquire, this to include any claim for dower. Dower being renounced on a separate instrument, which is attached hereto, included herein, and made a part hereof.

It is further specifically understood and agreed, that the said husband does hereby release and discharge the said wife from any and all duties, responsibilities or liabilities arising from said marriage and any claim which he has in any property which she now has or may hereinafter acquire.

It is further understood and agreed that the wife is to have the custody and control of their son, Thomas Edward Quinn, and that the said husband is to have the right and privilege of seeing said child at any reasonable and proper time.
