M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., as Lot No. 2 on the last mentioned plat and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

EEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of a five foot concrete sidewalk which runs along the east side of Cleveland Street, said beginning point being 344 feet South of the center line of University Ridge where it intersects with Cleveland Street, the said beginning point being the southwest corner of Lot now owned by the grantee and running thence with property of the grantee S. 89-45 E. 125 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with said alley S. 0-49 W. 23.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89-11 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the East side of the concrete sidewalk mentioned above; thence along the east side of said sidewalk N.
