in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert E. Maclay, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, at the southeast corner of Whitehall Street and Ashley Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of the property of Lillie J. Butler as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 33, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the intersection of Whitehall street and Ashley avenue (formerly South Woodside Circle), and running thence along the south side of Ashley avenue, S. 87-26 E. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13-50 W. 51.8 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 4; thence along the line of that lot, N. 81-03 W. 116 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Whitehall street; thence along the east side of Whitehall street, N. 24-37 E. 41 feet to the beginning corner.
