Its inlets, outlets, or beaches, nor authorize any unlawful, offensive or boisterous conduct, or the use of the said Lake by any person inexperienced in swimming; it being expressly stipulated that the granton herein, its shareholders or successors, shall not be liable to any lot owner or any other person for any damage or injury sustained in the exercise of the said privileges and facilities, or by reason hereof.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
