All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being between Ebaugh Avenue and the Laurens Road in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being a triangular strip off of the Northwest corner of Lot No. 74 of Boyce Addition as shown on Plat recorded in the R.
