


County, State of South Carolina being known as Lot No. 4, Block "D", Sterling Annex, recorded in Plat Book C, Page 81, Office of R. M. C., Green-ville County, May, 1913, and more particularly described as follows:

Starting at a point in the west line of Minus Street, 200 feet from the intersection of Minus Street and Valentine Street, the corner of Lot No. 3, runs thence with the line of said lot No.3, N. 44-50 W. 150.6 feet to a point, the corner of Lot No. 3; thence N. 47-45 E. 50 feet to a point, the southwest corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of Lot No. 5, S. 44-50 E. 150.6 feet to a point in the west line of Minus Street, the southeast corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the west line of the said Minus Street 50 feet to the beginning. This is the same lot of land as was conveyed to Martha L. Ewbank, executrix of the estate of Annie L. Caldwell by the Carolina Loan & Trust Company by its deed dated January 15th, 1936, recorded in Deed Book185. Page 153. Said lot of land was conveyed to the said Martha L. Ewbank as executrix in liquidation and settlement of an indebtedness due to her as such by the Carolina Loan and Trust Company and this conveyance is made by the said Martha L. Ewbank as executrix and by the beneficiaries of the estate of the said Annie L. Caldwell to-wit: Martha L. Ewbank and Abbie L. Butler.
