

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I. Edwin McT. Mearas.....

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the West side of Green Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as a portion of Lots 1 and 2 on Plat of Frank Hammond property, made by J. R. Lawrence, Surveyor, April 25, 1899, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book "DDD", Page 803 and having according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds to wit;

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Green Avenue about 45 feet North from a 12 foot alley and running thence with Green Avenue N. 27 E. 47 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 67 1/4 W. 130 feet 8 inches to an iron pin corner of lot known as the J. E. Holcombe lot; thence with the Holcombe lot line S. 14 W.57 1/2 feet to an iron pin on the Holcombe line; thence S. 70 E. 117 feet 9 inches to the beginning on Green Avenue.

This is the same property conveyed the Grantor by deed of Flora Lilliam Scott, dated November 1, 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 325, Page 353.

The Grantee assumes and agrees to pay the balance on that mort-gage given by Edwin McT. Meares to Flora Lillian Scott, dated November 1, 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville, S. C., in Volume 371, Page 374.

The Grantee is to pay 1948 taxes.
