of South Carolina, on the Southeastern side of U. S. Highway No. 29, being shown as Lot No. 104 on plat of the property of Vance Edwards, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P" at Pages 128 and 129, as revised, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of a 36-foot road running along the line of property of James M. Edwards and Robert J. Edwards, and running with said road, S. 48-42 E. 325 feet to an iron pin in line of other property of the grantor; thence with the line of said property, N. 42-52 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 103; thence with the line of Lot No. 103, N. 48-42 W. 325 feet to an iron pin on right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 29; thence with said right-of-way, S. 42-52 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
