1. That any residence erected in the above property shall face Eastview Drive;

2. That no residence shall be erected on said property costing less than Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars, exclusive of lot;

3. That no building shall be erected on said property nearer than Fifty Five (55) feet to the north side of Eastview Drive; 4. That said property shall be used for residential purposes

only and not for any commercial purposes;
5. No surface closet shall be placed or used on said property;
6. That no part of said property shall be sold or rented to, or otherwise disposed of to, any person or persons of African descent.
