KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Sophie B. Meares
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Two. Hundred Fifty
(\$2250.00)
to

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lewis W. Haselwood, his Heirs and
Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of Riverside Drive near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as parts of Lots 28 and 29 on plat of property of Ables and Rasor recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "E", Page 153, and having, according to a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, July 1945, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Riverside Drive, said pin being 12 feet West from the joint front corner of Lots 27 and 28, and running thence S. 22-22 E. 166.6 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 27 and 28; thence along the rear line of Lots 40 and 41; S. 64-29 W. 89 feet to an iron pin at corner of other property of Grantor; thence along line of other property of Grantor through Lot 29 N. 22-22 W. 165 feet more or less to an iron pin on the South side of Riverside Drive, said pin being 47.1 feet East from the joint front corner of Lots 29 & 30; running thence with the South side of Riverside Drive N. 63-28 E. 89 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to me by deed of John R. Torrence and Louis Mae Torrence, dated July 22, 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 316, Page 40.
