

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Sunny Lane joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17 and running thence with the line of Lot 16, N. 12-40 E. 599 feet to an iron pin in branch; thence down said branch as the line (the traverse line being N. 88-07 W. 228.3 feet) to a point in branch at rear corner of Lot 18; thence along the line of Lot 18, S. 11-45 W. 534 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Sunny Lane; thence with the North side of Sunny Lane, S. 70-45 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Sunny Lane along curved line(the chord being S. 72-05 E. 117 feet) to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that property devised to the Grantor, R.E. Dalton, under the will of R. A. Dalton, deceased, which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 230, File 25. And a portion of that inherited by me as the sole heir of Lucia Dalton Newton(nee Lucia Dalton Taylor) as shown in Apartment 522 File 26, Office of Probate Court for Greenville County.
