of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, on the South side of Laurens Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 59 of Glenn Grove Park, and having, according to plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, September 14, 1925, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
