BEGIN ING AT a point on the joint lines of Lots # 10 end ll where said line is crossed by a branch, which traverses Lot # 11, and run ing thence with the com on line of Lots # 10 and 11, S.71.04 run ing thence with the com on line of Lots # 10 and 11, S.71.04 run ing thence or less, to an iron pin on the line of the E, 550 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the line of the 65.9 acre tract sold to E.E.Chapman; thence alone the (hapman line 5.28.13 W. 253.5 feet to the corner of Lot # 12; thence along the common line of Lots. # 11 and 12, N.71.04 W, 525 feet, more or less, to a point where the branch above mentioned, crosses the common line of Lots # 11 and 12; thence in a Northeasterly direction, along the middle of the line of said branch a distance of 250 feet, have or less, to the point of beginning.

The above described property includes all of the original Lot #11, which lies to the east of said branch, and it is the understanding between the grantor and grantee that the branch, above mentioned, shall constitute the western boundry of the land herein conveyed.
