
THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF Greenville

State of South Carolina containing Twelve and twenty-nine one-hundredths (12.29) acres, more or less, adjoining lands of Henry Cooley, Rosia Henderson amd others, being a part of that certain tract of land conveyed to J. H. Cooley by John Cooley. See Deed Book M.N. at page 824.
