

Sears, Roebuck and Co., its successors and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being known as Lot No. 72 of Section H, as shown on plat of Stone Land Company, which is recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in plat book "A" at page 337.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of an unnamed street (now Mitchell Street) at a point 175 feet from Stone Avenue, running thence with the rear lines of Lots No. 62, 63 and 64, S. 71-50 E., 192 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-19 W., 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-50 W., 192 feet to an iron pin on the unnamed (now Mitchell) Street; thence with the unnamed (now Mitchell) street, N. 20-19 E., 55 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is identically the same as conveyed to Emma May Parks by W. G. Sirrine by deed dated January, 1923, recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in deed book 78 at page 470.
