all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying just outside the old city limits of Greer and South therefrom, lying on the West side of Line Street or State Highway No. 101 and on the South side of a street, formerly and a part of 15 known as 21st Street, being all of lots Nos. 13 and 14/as appears on plat on record in the R.M.C.
