

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler

Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Laurens Road, known and designated as lot No. 9 of the property of Mary V. Harmon according to survey and plat made by Dalton and Neves March 1944 and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a pin on the West side of the Laurens Road at the Northeast corner of lot 8, thence with line of lot 8, S. 64-30 W. 609 feet to a pin; thence N. 21-09 W. 132.4 feet to pin, corner of lot No. 10; thence with line of lot 10, N. 64-30 E. 597 feet to pin on the West side of Laurens Road; thence along the West side of said road S. 25-30 E. 132 feet to beginning corner, containing 1.82 acres, more or less.

The above land the same conveyed to James Oliver Batson by Mary V. Harmon on the 30th day of April, 1947 and recorded in Book 311, page 183.

Also all the piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Laurens Road, known and designated as lot No. 10 of the property of Mary V. Harmon according to survey and plat made by Dalton and Neves March 1944 and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a pin on the West side of the Laurens Road, at the Mortheast corner of lot No. 9, and running thence with line of lot No. 9, S. 64-30 W. 597 feet to a pin; thence N. 21-09 W. 185 feet to a pin; thence N. 69-37 E. 583.5 feet to pin on the West 31 > 2f Laurens Road: thence along the West side of the Laurens Road S. 25-30 E. 132 feet to beginning corner, containing 2.12 acres, more or less.
