

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the Greenville and Pelham Road, being a portion of property formerly known as the Estate of Sunie S. Bull and having, according to survey by W. J. Riddle dated November 30, 1948, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Greenville and Pelham Road at corner of other property of Hoke Smith and running thence along the line of other property of Hoke Smith S. 4-10 W. 1822 feet to a stake on the bank of creek; thence with the creek as the line by following a traverse line S. 82-30 E. 312 feet to an iron pin; N. 52-0 E. 920 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69-30 E. 320 feet to a birch; thence along the line of property of DeCamp N. 2-45 W. 8 90 feet to a stake; thence continuing along the line of property of DeCamp N. 51-15 W. 739 feet to a stake in the center of road; thence along center of said Greenville and Felham Road N. 85-0 W. 577 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning, containing approximately 41.50, acres, more or less.
