Alderman Batson offered the following resolution and moved adoption:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the below described alleyway, shown on the same leading from the south side of MoKay Street, in Ward 6, in the City of Greenville, S. C., has never been wied, opened or accepted by the City of Greenville for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is impractical to use or open the same, and the City disclaims any interest therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, HE IT RESOLVED BY THE GREENVILLE CITY
COUNCIL IN REGULAR SESSION, ASSEMBLED THIS THE 23RD DAY OF MOVEMBER,
1948, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

1. That an unopened alleyway, having width of fifteen (15) feet, more or less, extending from McKay Street toward Tindal Avenue, in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville, S. C., described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south side of McKay Street. 383 feet, more or less, from the corner of ugusta Street, thence, in a southerly direction 226.5 feet to a point 12.5 feet north of Tindal Avenue; thence in an electrically direction 15 feet to a point 6.3 feet from Tindal Avenue; thence, in a northerly direction 232.4 feet to a point on the south side of McKay Street; thence in a westerly direction 15 feet along the south side of McKay Street to the beginning point.

be and the same is hereby abandoned or disclaimed by the City of Greenville, S. C.

2. That it has found that said alley has never been opened, graded, or used by the City or by the public for street purposes and it is found that it is impractical to do so, and the City expressly relinquishes any claim of any nature whatsoever which it may have in or to said alleyway.
