, A. D1948, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' , a newspaper published in the Greenville Piedmont notice in the

County of Greenville

, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said \hat{D} celarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The manue of the proposed Corporation is; THE GREENVILLE ALUMNI OF THETA CHI FRATERNITY, INC.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Furman University, GREENVILLE, S.C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to maintain a fraternal order affiliated with the National Chapter of Theta Chi Fraternity, engaging in the usual social and fraternal activities of such an organization. To hold property and to further maintain a fraternity house for the use and benefit of the undergraduate members of Theta Chi enrolled at Furman University and the alumni members of said fraternity.
