That in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid to the Industry by the Power Company, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Industry does hereby lease, for the period and subject to the terms and con-ditions hereinafter set out, to the Power Company, the following described premises, to-wit, (A) that certain lot of land, and (B) that certain right of way, lying and being in or near the Town of Paris, Greenville County, South Carolina:

- (A) That lot described as follows: BEGINNING at a point located N. 55 - 46 E., 151.5 ft. from a point in the easterly wall of the warehouse of the Industry, which last point is 377 feet measured along said wall in a northerly direction from the southeast corner of said warehouse, and running thence from said point of beginning as so established, N. 34 - 14 W., 18 ft.; thence N. 55 - 46 E., 40 ft.; thence S. 34 - 14 E., 18 ft.; thence S. 55 - 46 W., 40 ft. to the point of BEGINNING, being shown within red lines on print dated December 10, 1948, hereto attached and made a part hereof, together with the right to construct, maintain and operate two poles, appliances thereon and connections therewith, indicated on the attached print as "2 - poles by D.
