

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville City Rossoskip. Greenville County, State of South Carolina

This lot being a portion of lots 46,46-A and 47 according to a plat recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville county in plat book "A" page 153,&is described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of McKay Street 118 feet westwardly from Palmetto Ave. and running thence along McKay Street S.88-30W. 32 feet more or less to the rear corner on said street of lot No. 46 on said plat; thence along the rear lines of the said lots 46, 46-A and 40 eighty feet to a stake in the rear line of lot No. 47; thence in an Easterly direction parallel to McKay Street 32 feet more or less to a stake which is 112 feet from Palmetto St; thence in a southerly direction 80 feet to the beginning.

By this, is meant to describe the western half of a lot conveyed to E. Godfrey Webster by deed of Amy Toland dated 30 March 1929 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in deed book 150 pg. 327. Out of this shall be reserved a strip 5 feet wide and 50 feet deep (on the east side of said lot), which strip shall be used as 1/2 of a joint drive way, commencing on the North side of McKay Street and extending back therefrom to above depth.
