## WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the premises, payments, covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, by each of the parties to be respectively kept and performed, the Lessor does hereby lease, demise and let unto the Lessees the real property located at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Rutherford Road (sometime called Camp Road) and Oeland Drive, being part of shown as/Lot # 1 on plat of property of Paul J.
