COURT OF COMMON PLEASAGREEMENT FOR EASEMENT AND  
RIGHT-OF-WAY.

For and in consideration of the sum of six hundred  
\$600 00 (Dollars) to me in hand paid (receipt of  
which is hereby acknowledged), I (we) A. R. Scumble,  
Grantor, do hereby bargain, grant and sell to J. L. STEVENS CO.  
C., INC., Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, the right,  
privilege and easement to erect, maintain, repair and replace  
poles, guys, cross-arms and electric transmission lines over and  
across the following described property:

I have certain tract of land in Greenville County, S.C. lying  
bath of the City of Greer and on the west side of New Pelham  
Road and on the bath side of a road leading from New Pelham  
Road in a westerly direction to Pelham Road and designated  
on the Greenville County Block Books as tracts "E 2 - 3 - 4 1/4", "E 2 - 3 - 6",  
and "E 2 - 3 - 7". The poles shall be erected on or near the  
Northern property line of the grantor at such points as the  
grantee shall determine. The right of way and easement  
shall extend for a width of 15 feet from the center line of  
the poles. The privilege is also extended to the grantee  
its successors and assigns to relocate said line over  
the premises to conform to any future highway or street  
relocation, widening or improvement.

J. L. STEVENS CO., INC., its agents and servants,  
their successors and assigns, shall have the right, privilege and  
easement to go in and on said property at all reasonable times for  
the purpose of inspecting, repairing and replacing the poles,  
wires, cross-arms and transmission lines and the right is further  
granted to J. L. STEVENS CO., INC., its agents and servants,  
their successors and assigns, to trim, cut or remove such trees,  
shrubbery or underbrush as may be necessary from time to time to  
keep the poles, wires and transmission lines free of obstructions.
