All that certain tract of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about six miles west of the City of Greenville, near Saluda River, containing 49.67 acres, more or less, being Tracts Nos. 7, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of a Subdivision of Cherry Investment Company, being a portion of the old Hattie Cunningham Farm, and having in the aggregate the following metes and bounds according to plat of W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated February 17, 1938:

Beginning at a stake in road, in line of Tract No. 5 on said plat (which tract was sold to A. M. Lesley and Maggie L. Lesley), and running thence with Lesley line and line of W. A.
