



All that certain lot of land in the County of Greenville, Gantt Township, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 10 according to plat of property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, said lot having the following metes and bounds, according to plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 7:
