

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 55 of Dukeland Park, property of Colonia Company, as per plat of Dalton & Neves, made June, 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in plat book "J", at pages 220 and 221, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Dukeland Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 55 and 56, and running thence with the line of lots 55 and 56, N. 35-42 W. 152.5 feet to an iron pin on Langston Creek; thence along the line of Langston Creek N. 71-33 E. 52.3 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 54 and 55; thence along the common line of lots Nos. 54 and 55, S. 35-42 E. 137 feet to an iron pin on Dukeland Drive; thence along the Northwest side of Dukeland Drive S. 54-18 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
