C., near the Dunean Mills Village and extending through property of the grantor herein which lies between Wallace Street and Mills Avenue Extension, all of which is more fully shown on a plat of the right-of-way for Stevens Street Extension, Greenville County, S. C., made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., March 28, 1949, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book V, at page 157. The property herein conveyed is to be used by Greenville County, S. C., for the purpose of extending Stevens Street from Wallace Street through to Mills Avenue Extension. This conveyance is made in conjunction with a similar conveyance by F. H. Earle conveying to Greenville County such a part of the roadway as runs entirely through or partly through the property of F. H. Earle which adjoins property of the grantor herein. The boundary line between the property of F. H. Earle and J. P.
