

in the State aforesaid (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W. King Jr.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and ocing in Old Hundred School District, (2 A), in Oaklawn Township, in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid. Containing Twentyfour and one-half (24) acres, more or less, and being bounded as follows. On the North by lands, now or formerly, of E.L. King and J.W.King Jr.; on the East by lands, now or formerly, of Erc Lois Boyce; on the South by lands, now or formerly, of E.Z. Ros; on the West by lands, now or formerly, of J. W.King Sr.

The above being the real property left to the grantor herein by the will of George W.King, deceased. Said will being duly probated in the office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County S.C. in June 1936. And being the identical tract of land conveyed to George W.King by John J. Slaten by deed dated October 29th, 1910 and recorded June 27th, 1936 in the office R.M.C. for Greenville County S.C. in Volume 171 at page 386.
