

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, located near the City of Greenville, lying on the
 west side of Lanford Street, being shown and being the lot
 No. 30 on Plat of Property known as "Lanford Street," and
 being the same lot of land that was conveyed to me by deed from
 E. Inman, Master, said deed recorded in Deed Book 323 at page 100,
 and having the following courses and dimensions, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the west side of Lanford Street
 100 feet north from the intersection of Barbaree Street, joint
 corner of lots 79 and 80, and runs thence with the west line
 line of lots 79 and 80, N. 87-50 W. 142.6 feet to a stone on
 Brannon or Green Street; thence with the east line of said
 Brannon or Green street L. 18-50 E. 31 feet to a stone, joint
 corner of lots 80 and 81; thence with the dividing line of
 lots 80 and 81, S. 87-50 E. 185 feet to a stone on the east
 side of Lanford Street; thence with the west side of Lanford
 Street, S. 3-20 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
