STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, J. B. Orders of Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privileges and easement to go in and upon that tract of land, situated in Greenville Township, in the said County and State, bounded by lands of Southern Railroad Co. and other lands of the Grantor. This right-of-way crosses the West part of Lot #152 of Block 9, Sheet 175 as shown on the County Block Book. To construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line, air vents, blow off connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspedting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line all trees and other obstructions that may in any way 'endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same.

It is understood and agreed that the right-of-way to be used under this contract during construction is to be fifty feet in width throughout the entire length which is approximately (81) feet, and the damage, which the City of Greenville is to be liable for during construction, is to be confined to this strip and nothing beyond. The location of the pipe line, when laid, will determine the definite location of the right-of-way. The center of the pipe line shall be accepted as lying fifteen feet from the East boundary line of this right-of-way. The remaining thirty-five feet of said right-of-way during construction shall lie West of the center of said pipe line and the entire right-of-way may be used for the purpose of installing the pipe line. The location of said pipe line is to be approximately along the line now located and staked out by the engineers subject to a variation of not exceeding five feet either way. The permanent right-of-way, after the pipe line is installed, shall be thirty feet in width measuring fifteen feet from the center on each side of said pipe line as laid, and no obstruction shall hereafter be placed on said thirty foot right-ofway.

It is further understood that the owner is to have the right to cultivate and use this right-of-way strip of land, provided, such use thereof shall not interfere with the proper maintenance and free access to the pipe line to be installed under this agreement.

It is further agreed that in case of future damages to property or crop, due from an accident on the pipe line that the City of Greenville shall pay all damages.

The payment above specified covers compensation for the easement or right-of-way, and also covers all claims for damages along said right-of-way resulting from construction of the line to be laid.
